Meeting held on 05/10/2021

Resolutions Taken:

Meeting held on 09/11/2021

Resolutions Taken:

- 1. Although the IQAC had resolved to invite NAAC by 2020, the college could not proceed to invite due to various hindrances and Pandemic of COVID-19 has slowed down the preparation for the same. Discussing the importance of Assessment and Accreditation the meeting resolved to invite NAAC by 2023.
- 2. Resolved to conduct special classes for Slow Learners and Quiz, Debate and other Competitions for the Advance Learners.
- 3. Resolved to fix the intake capacity of new admission at 700 for each year.
- 4. Resolved to initiate a survey in the locality under Ananya, the women's Forum in collaboration with Departments of English and Assamese, on women awareness after the pandemic of Covid-19.
- 5. It is resolved that Ananya, the Women Forum will celebrate the Children Day in the local Lower Primary School (123 No. DhamdhamaNimnaBuniyadiVidyalaya). It is further resolved that Anaya will carry on different activities like workshop, seminars for the benefits of our girl students.
- 6. It is resolved that the faculties will visit student's home to interact with the parents to know issues and problems of the students after the pandemic of Covid-19.
- 7. Realizing the need of proper guidance to the talented students of the college who aspire to qualify different Competitive Examination, the meeting resolved to initiate a special mission "Mission Super 10" by selecting 10 talented students every year and give them proper guidance to face such exams. It is further resolved that NabajitBaishya, Assistant Professor of Department of Political Science will serve as the co-ordinator of the mission.

- 6. 'Ananya', has also organized a workshop on Cake Baking to help the students to be financially independent through small entrepreneur like cake baking.

- 8. "Mission Super 10" has been started and 10 students have been selected to carry out the mission.
- 9. Pig Health and Awareness Camp cum Feed Distribution programme has been organized under the initiative of IQAC in collaboration with ICAR National Research Centre on Pig and State Animal Husbandry Department, Govt. of Assam.
- 10. Financial help has been provided to RingkhangshriBaro who has been suffering from severe health issues since a long time. The fund for the assistance has been collected from the faculty members.

Meeting held on 30/12/2021

Resolutions Taken:

- 5. Plantation programmes has been organized by different cells of the college like NSS, NCC, Ananya (The women's Cell). Medicinal garden is on growth. Process for ISO Certification has been started.
- 6. Awareness programme on Waste Management has been organized.
- 7. A three day Capacity Building Training Programme of NIELIT has been organized at the college. It has covered Awareness Programme on Cyber Security and Emerging Technologies to Students, awareness Programme on Use of Mobile Application for Digital Payment And e-Governance Services for elderly persons, awareness programme for farmers on use of ICT technologies for effective farming and marketing and awareness programme for women on use of mobile applications for Digital Payment, E-Governance services IT application and cyber security.
